June 19, 2014

Opening:

- A. Call to Order** - The regular meeting of the Missouri One Call System Operating Committee was called to order at 10:00 a.m. on June 19, 2014 by Pat Koury, Meeting Chairman.

Beth gave a presentation on the various highway designs that are being implemented throughout the state which are proving to reduce accidents and fatalities.

- Call volume – YTD up 23.75% and continues to exceed all expectations.
 - The usage for ITIC (Internet Ticketing) Users is on track to meet the 60% goal for 2014.
 - Discussed how the law changes will affect utilities and excavators.
 - Daily Audit format has been changed to only 2 columns.

- a) Public Awareness – Dave Jones
April Safe Digging Month Activities
- MoDOT promoted 811 on their electronic signage throughout the state
 - Fire Station Banner Program – 100 entries, drawing for 40” TV. Winner was Eastern Douglas County Volunteer Fire Department, Drury, MO.
 - CGA promoted their online Can-You-Dig-It game. 122,000 people nationwide played for over \$5000 in prizes.

Other activities and promotions:

- Promoted safe digging programs for 3rd graders in schools throughout the state
- KC T-Bones, Springfield Cardinals and River City Rascals, signage at their games
- 811 Day – August 9, 2014, Southern Mo Gas will sponsor a 5K run in Shawnee Mission, KS. MOCS staff will be on hand to help promote the run.
- State Fair – August 7-17 – MOCS Educational Trailer will be on display. Staff and volunteers will provide hand-outs, 811 tattoos, pencils, etc.
- MOCS Yard Signs – are being promoted in the KC Metro area and are being given to the excavators to place at their dig-site to promote the fact they called in a locate request to have the underground facilities located.

- b) Legislative Activities – Recently passed legislation to RSMO 319.010 – 319.050. (Bill is still subject to the Governor’s signature and will not become law until he signs it or permits it to become law without his signature on July 14, 2014.
